*On January 28th, 2010 a homeless count in
Tillamook County revealed:*

- 267 families were counted as homeless
- Of those 267 families, 61 families were counted living in their cars, in tents and on the street
- Of those 267 families, there were more than 100 children under the age of 18 and 81 young adults between the ages of 18 and 23

As members of the Tillamook County community, what can we do to help those who are experiencing homelessness? What can we do to assure that our children and young adults have stable homes to support their success as adults? How can we work together to ensure Tillamook has a home for everyone who needs one?

On July 22, C.A.R.E., Inc. and Tillamook County Commission on Children and Families will hold a one day summit to work on housing solutions for Tillamook County. Experts from across the state of Oregon have been invited to come and share what solutions other communities have chosen and to help Tillamook County choose the best solutions for our community.
